

## **REBECCA OTT**

#### BIOGRAPHY

Rebecca Ott was born in 1971 in Toronto, Canada. She studied both architecture and computer graphics before pursuing a career in fine art.

Working in traditional media such as oil painting and etching, she also explores how technology shapes our images and our sense of place.

Her subject matter is drawn from both the complexity and silent expansiveness of the landscape, and she finds inspiration in nature and the urban environment.

Rebecca lives and works in Toronto, Canada.

#### ARTIST STATEMENT

I aim to explore the sculptural forms, patterning, and scale of the environment through my artistic practice which includes painting, drawing and printmaking. In my observation of light, shadow and scale, I attempt to capture the quiet monumentality of my surroundings in relationship to the natural world.

In 2018, I started a discipline of creating one collage a day and documenting/archiving these works on my @reb.ott INSTAGRAM account. Here I experiment with the intuitive creation of form, colour relationships and mark-making trying to capture a feeling about the landscape, rather than a realistic representation.

Starting in 2022, I experimented with the new artificial intelligence of the Generative Adversarial Network.

Using my original hand-made paper collages as an image set, I trained a GAN to generate collage images that I could share on social media along with my hand-made collages.
